Trade Offs to Consider

- No GPS for outdoor tracking
- Limited screen size for detailed data
- Battery life not ideal for heavy use
- No photo-taking feature without a phone
- No long-term battery life beyond 7 days
- Limited connectivity options compared to smartwatches
