Trade Offs to Consider

-  Shorter battery life in GPS mode vs. battery saver
-  Limited music storage without subscription
-  Complex interface for casual users
-  Higher cost compared to basic smartwatches
-  No medical certification for health metrics
-  Bulkier than minimalist fitness trackers
