Trade Offs to Consider

-  No medical-grade health metrics
-  Requires smartphone pairing
-  Limited to 50,000 lux solar exposure
-  Not suitable for underwater use
-  Bluetooth-only connectivity
-  Pulse Ox not available in all regions

- Fewer health metrics than medical devices
- Requires smartphone for full functionality
- Less lightweight than slim smartwatches
