Who It Is For

-  Fitness enthusiasts needing GPS and music storage
-  Users prioritizing long battery life for daily wear
-  Individuals requiring health metrics tracking

Who It Is Not For

-  Users without a compatible smartphone for notifications
-  Those needing GPS-only devices without music storage
-  People prioritizing short battery life for frequent charging
-  Individuals without access to Garmin Connect app
-  Wristwearers with sizes outside 125-190mm range
-  Users avoiding contactless payment features

Trade Offs to Consider

-  Battery life reduces in GPS mode with music playback
-  Display brightness may drain power faster
-  Limited storage capacity for music files
-  Requires smartphone for full functionality
-  GPS accuracy depends on signal availability
-  No physical buttons for quick access
