## Who It Is Not For

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-  Users under 22 years old (ECG unavailable)
-  Those without compatible Android phones
-  People needing full waterproofing
-  Users without a Fitbit account
-  Individuals relying on built-in GPS
-  Those avoiding subscription fees

## Trade Offs to Consider

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-  Battery life decreases with active features
-  Water resistance limited to shallow water
-  No built-in GPS requires phone pairing
-  Band options vary by region
-  Requires phone for full functionality
-  Subscription fees for premium features
