## Trade Offs to Consider

---

-  No GPS for location tracking
-  Limited watch face customization
-  Requires smartphone for full functionality
-  Battery life may decrease with heavy use
-  No advanced health metrics beyond basic tracking
-  Limited durability in extreme conditions
