## Trade Offs to Consider

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-  Limited battery life for heavy usage
-  Higher cost compared to basic smartwatches
-  No third-party app support
-  Water resistance limited to 50m
-  Requires Android device for full functionality
-  Slightly heavier than standard smartwatches
